



Enjoy a cultural and art-full day in Hyannis!

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This summer look for the **FREE trolley** that loops from the Hyannis Transportation Center, Main Street to Ocean Street to Hyannis Harbor. The trolley runs from June 26th to September 6, 2010, from 11 am to 9 pm and takes approximately 30 minutes. Just wave it down or stop wherever you see the trolley sign. Hop the trolley and begin your day down at Veteran's Beach to visit the **JFK Memorial and the Korean War Memorial**.

Take the trolley or it's a short walk from Veteran's Beach to Hyannis Harbor. **Hyannis Harbor** is a bustling, colorful working harbor complete with waterfront restaurants, fishing boats, harbor cruises, even a pirate boat! Stroll among the seven colorful **artist shanties** at the harbor on Bismore Park, next to the visitor center. **Meet local artists** who display and sell their work seven days a week. You will find **local entertainment at the shanties** on many afternoons.

Follow the shell walkway along the harbor front to **Aselton Park**, on the corner of South and Ocean Streets, where you can enjoy cool breezes and take a picture under the colorful public art installation Buoyed Coast, which is on display from May to November. **Beginning June 29th, you can enjoy free concerts featuring local bands from 6-7:30PM, evenings on Tuesdays, Friday's and Sunday's.** **Cape Cod Maritime Museum**, is located right next to Aselton Park.

Stroll along the "**walkway to the sea**", a wave-patterned brick path that winds from the harbor front through the beautiful village green to Main Street. You will come upon the **JFK Museum and Cape Cod Baseball Hall of Fame Museum**. Just one street over from Main Street is the **Zion Union Heritage Museum** located at 276 North Street.

Just a few steps away is **Pearl Street** where art is cultured! Check out the artist work studios at 50 Pearl Street open most Saturday's, usually weekdays and always by appointment. Sarah Holl Artspace at 46 Pearl Street is open on Saturday's from 1- 4 pm, weekdays by chance, and always by appointment.

Right next door is the **Guyer Art Barn**, 250 South Street, Hyannis, is open year round for exhibits & classes on Saturday's and Sunday's from NOON - 4 pm. The barn is a community art space showcasing the talents of emerging and established artists.

On Thursdays in July and August from 5 to 8 pm, both at the individual work studios and also at the Guyer Art Barn, the artists host open studios where you will get a chance to meet them and view their work.

Ready for shopping? On Main Street there are over 150 shops and 40 restaurants for some retail therapy and fortification! Enjoy the weekly street festival on Thursday's in July and August from 6 to 9 pm.

Take one more block over and you will find the Hyannis Youth & Community Center (Basset Lane). The HYCC is a full service community center with two skating rinks(public skating year round) , basketball courts skateboard park and a game room.
