Sarah Holl ARTspace @ 46 Pearl

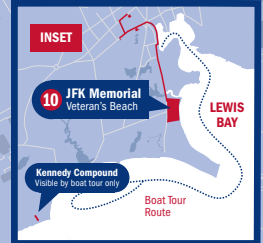
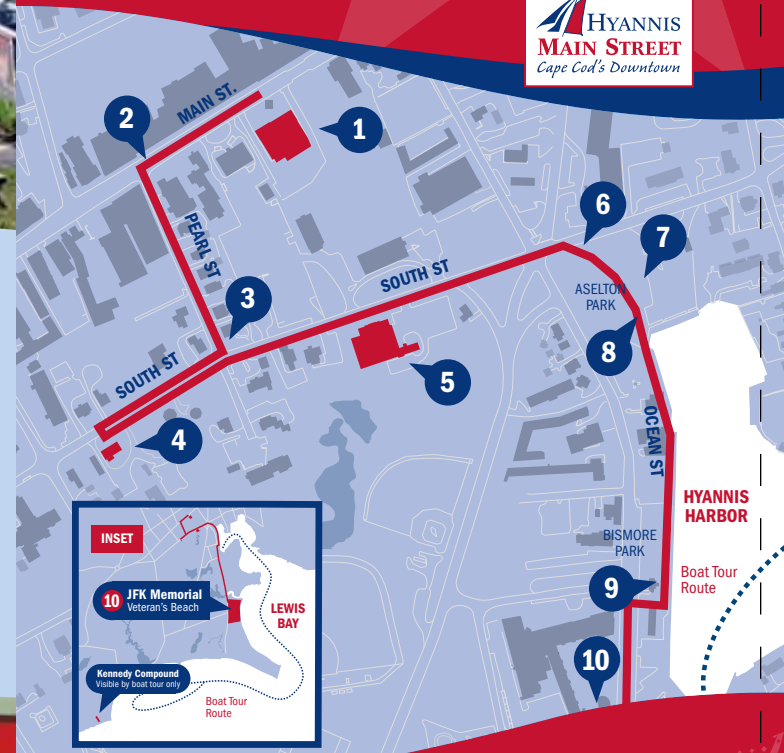

Walkway to the Sea

Follow the wave patterned brick path winding from Main Street Hyannis through the Village Green to the harborfront.

Stop at Aselton Park where you can enjoy cool breezes and take a picture under the colorful public art installation "Buoyed Coast" (on display April-October).
